























































































































































































































































## HOW TO PLAY TEXAS HOLD 'EM

- 1. THE DEALER, STARTING TO HIS LEFT, DEALS EACH PLAYER 2 CARDS FACE-DOWN.
- 2. THEN BASED ON THOSE CARDS ALONE, THE 1ST ROUND OF BETTING BEGINS TO THE DEALER'S LEFT.
- 3. NEXT, 3 COMMUNITY CARDS, KNOWN AS "THE FLOP," ARE DEALT FACE-UP IN THE CENTER OF THE TABLE. BETTING BEGINS AGAIN WITH THE FIRST PLAYER STILL IN THE HAND ON THE DEALER'S LEFT.
- 4. THE 4TH COMMUNITY CARD, "THE TURN," IS DEALT TO THE CENTER, FOLLOWED BY ANOTHER ROUND OF RETTING
- 5. THE 5TH AND FINAL COMMUNITY CARD, "THE RIVER," IS DEALT AND A FINAL ROUND OF BETTING BEGINS.
- 6. THE PLAYERS REMAINING IN THE HAND THEN TURN THEIR CARDS OVER TO REVEAL THE WINNER.

DUE TO SEVERAL ROUNDS OF BETTING AND THE GAME'S "NO-LIMIT" STYLE, THE POTS CAN GROW FAST AND FURIOUSLY. HOWEVER, SINCE 5 OF THE 7 CARDS ARE SHARED BY THE ENTIRE TABLE, THE ABILITY TO PULL OFF A GOOD BUJF IS KEY. THE BEST CARDS DON'T ALWAYS WIN THE HAND, THE BEST PLAYERS DO.

HOLD'EM TAKES A MINUTE TO LEARN AND A LIFETIME TO MASTER.
